Welcome and Opening Remarks

(Note to Contest Toastmaster: In this script, things you are to **do** are described in italic text like this. Things you are to **say** are in regular text like this.)

In your own words, welcome everyone. Be sure to point out the locations of exits and restrooms. Remind everyone to turn off any device that makes noise.

Recognize all District 30 dignitaries who are present. Follow the sequence of the dignitaries sheet. Protocol for this announcement is to give the person's position title and Toastmasters educational level (if available).

The first contest will be the Evaluation Contest.

When that contest has concluded, we will take a short break. Following the break, we will hold the International Speech Contest.

Evaluation Contest Overview & Introduction

Contestants, timers, ballot counters and the Sergeant-at-Arms have all been briefed on their responsibilities prior to the beginning of this contest. Everyone is aware of the Toastmasters International rules that govern this contest.

Once the contest has begun, the Sergeant-at-Arms will secure the doors. No one should enter or leave the room during the contestants' presentations. You may do so if time permits during the minute of silence between presentations. After the contestants have finished their presentations, please remain silent and do not leave the room until the announcement that all ballots have been collected.
